

Cybersecurity Tabletop Exercise

Purpose of Training:

Cybersecurity threats are ever-evolving, and organizations must be prepared to defend against them. The purpose of this training is to equip you with the knowledge and skills to effectively respond to cyber incidents through a tabletop exercise. By simulating real-world scenarios in a controlled environment, we aim to enhance your ability to identify, assess, and mitigate cybersecurity risks.

Audience:

This training is designed for leadership and department heads. A successful tabletop should have representation from senior leadership, HR, IT, Finance, and all of the key functions or departments in your organization.

How to Prepare:

- ✓ Assemble a cross-functional team representing various departments and key stakeholders.
- ✓ Review and familiarize yourself with your organization's incident response plan.
- ✓ Ensure all participants have access to a current copy of the incident response plan.
- ✓ Communicate the date, time, and location of the tabletop exercise to all participants.

Outline of the Training:

1. Introductions:

Each individual will have the opportunity to introduce themselves and explain their respective roles.

2. Review of Scenario:

There will be a review of a simulated cyber event scenario, followed by defining and assigning roles and responsibilities to participants throughout the exercise.

3. Tabletop Exercise Execution:

- Engage in the simulated cyber incident scenario, guided by facilitators.
- Practice communication, decision-making, and incident response procedures based on your organization's incident response plan.
- Understand how multi-week outages of all computer and network systems may impact critical functions in your organization.

4. Debrief and Lessons Learned:

- Reflect on the exercise experience and discuss key takeaways.
- Identify strengths, weaknesses, and areas for improvement.
