

Cybersecurity Training for Leadership

Purpose:

- 6. Important Policies:** Identifying and implementing key cybersecurity policies and procedures to govern data handling, access controls, incident response, and other critical areas.
- 7. Leadership Best Practices for Cybersecurity:** Best practices for leaders to foster a culture of cybersecurity awareness, prioritize resources, and champion cybersecurity initiatives within their organizations.
